Anywhere

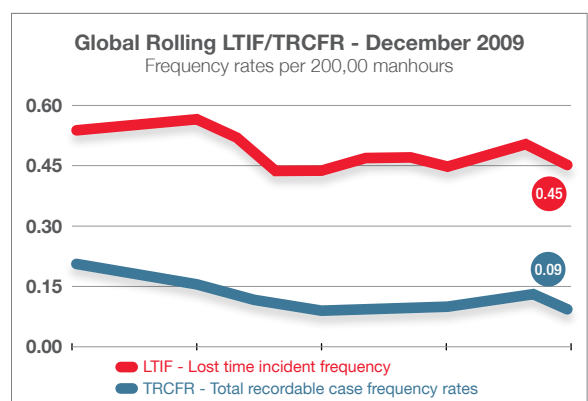

2009 HIGHLIGHTS

Girassol Pipeline Repair Project / Angola

In December 2009, Subsea 7 announced the successful completion of the Girassol Pipeline Repair Project for Total E&P Angola. The project was an entirely diverless pipeline repair in 1350 metres water.

New State-of-the-Art Vessel Commences First Project, North Sea

In November 2009, Subsea 7's new state-of-the-art remotely operated vehicle support vessel, the 'Normand Subsea', commenced her first project for Shell in the Ormen Lange field in the Norwegian sector of the North Sea.

Petrobras / Brazil

In October 2009, Subsea 7 was awarded a contract by Petrobras to engineer, procure, fabricate, install and commission one 12" gas export line and one 12" oil export line connecting the P-55 platform to the PRA-1 platform in the Roncador field, offshore Brazil.

Contract Value: \$200m

Santos Limited / Asia Pacific

In September 2009, Subsea 7 was awarded a contract by Santos Limited to install a rigid pipeline, an electro hydraulic umbilical and 4 rigid spool pieces in the Casino Henry field, offshore Victoria, Australia.

Contract Value: \$80m

Petrobras / Brazil

In August 2009, Subsea 7 was awarded a long-term contract by Petrobras (Petroleo Brasileiro S/A) for the exclusive use of its pipelay vessel the Normand Seven, for a period of four years, commencing Q3 2009.

Contract Value: \$250m

BP / Africa

In July 2009, Subsea 7 was awarded awarded a pipeline engineering, construction and installation contract for a gas export pipeline (GEL) project in BP's Block 18 field in Angola, offshore West Africa.

Contract Value: \$150m

BP / Norway

In July 2009, Subsea 7 was awarded a contract by BP Norway, for engineering, procurement, installation and commissioning (EPIC) of the Valhall Flank Gas Lift Pipelines and Wellhead Platform Riser Caisson project in the Norwegian sector of the North Sea.

Contract value: \$40m

Nexen / UK

In April 2009, Subsea 7 was awarded an exclusive 3 year frame agreement contract with Nexen Petroleum U.K. Limited for subsea field development works on all its UK assets.

Total / The Netherlands

In April 2009 Subsea 7 was awarded an engineering, procurement, installation and commissioning (EPIC) contract by Total E&P Nederland B.V. for the flowlines and subsea works on the K5CU Development Project in the Dutch sector of the North Sea.

Contract value: \$26m

Petrobras / Brazil

In March 2009 Subsea 7 was awarded a contract from Petrobras (Petroleo Brasileiro S/A) for the Tambau Urugua and P-56 developments in the deepwater Santos and Campos Basins offshore Brazil.

Awards

Marathon Oil / Gulf of Mexico

In August Subsea 7 won the first contract for its new fabrication and spoolbase facility at Port Isabel, Texas. The subsea pipelay fabrication and installation contract was awarded by Marathon Oil Corporation.

Contract value: \$45m

StatoilHydro / Norway

The award of a contract from StatoilHydro in August for engineering, procurement, construction and installation of the Troll B Gas Injection project in the Norwegian sector of the North Sea.

Contract value: \$100m

BP Block 31 / offshore Angola

During July, the company was awarded its largest contract to date in Africa. The contract is a framework agreement with call-off services in support of BP's Block 31 development programme in offshore west Africa. The first call-off is for the Plutao, Saturno, Venus and Marte fields.

Contract value: \$460m

Venture Production / UK

Subsea 7 has a unique Partnership Agreement with Venture Production to perform all of Venture's subsea engineering, construction and inspection repair and maintenance (IRM) works in the North Sea.

Contract value: \$70m

Sul Capixaba Pipeline / Brazil

In January Subsea 7 was awarded an EPIC contract with Petrobras, in the Espirito Santo Basin offshore Brazil for the design, engineering, procurement, fabrication and installation of the Sul Capixaba Export Gas Pipeline and end termination assembly in the Jubarte field.
